## 4. ACCOMMODATION & MEALS



**4.1.** Accommodation along with full board (three meals) is being provided at a 5-star hotel i.e. Leela Ambience Convention Hotel by the organizers for the team members from 16th to 23rd June, 2022 on a single/twin sharing basis.

### 4.2.

The airport to the hotel is approx. 30-35 kms.

The Hotel to the cycling velodrome is about 12-15 kms.

**4.3.** All teams have to pay the accommodation and full boarding expenses in US Dollar in advance.

- USD 80 per person per day for twin sharing room (Meals included)
- USD 100 per person per day for single room (Meals included)

#### 4.4. The Official hotel is Leela Ambience Convention Hotel, New Delhi

Leela Ambience Convention Hotel is an elegant 5-star property located on Maharaj Surajmal Road Near Yamuna Sports Complex. It is well placed on NH 24 and is not only an ideal base for Himalayan getaways but also just 2.5 hrs drive to Agra. The city centre is 20 min by road while the metro station is just 5 min drive away. Nearby attractions include India's largest mosque, Jama Masjid, the historic residence of the Mughals Red Fort, and the war memorial India Gate.



## 5. TRANSPORTATION



**5.1.** The transportation (only one pick up and drop) from the airport to the hotel is provided to the teams. Any team that requires additional transport facility to the airport and back will be charged.

**5.2.** All teams must confirm their arrival 5 days in advance to help arrange their pickup from the airport to Hotel.

**5.3.** Transportation charges are included with the accommodation fee and only the teams staying in the official hotel are provided with free transportation.

**7.3.** Managers are reminded to bring the licenses of all the participants and supporting staff including Team Managers. Please bring the passport for Date of Birth verification of junior riders and the team jersey at the time of confirmation of starter list.

**7.4.** The Rider numbers will be issued to Team Managers after confirmation of starters during the Team Managers Meeting . If any changes of entries are required by any team they must inform to the Race Secretary of the Commissaire Panel Room located at Cycling Velodrome by ..... Hrs for the next day events.

**7.5.** Unless due to Force De Majeure, a rider once announced as taking start and who fails to do so, shall be liable to a fine of 500 CHF to 5000 CHF. Injuries or illness will not be accepted as a valid reason unless the rider is declared unfit to start by the official doctor.

## 7.6. Team Representation

Each National Federation shall designate a Team Manager for each team (i.e. Elite Men, Elite Women, Junior Men & Junior Women) participating in the championships.

The Team Managers of the respective teams are representatives of their National Federation. If any contact with the teams shall be made, it will be through the Team Manager.

## 7.7. Equipment

Equipment used in cycling competitions MUST comply with Chapter 3 of Part 1 of UCI rules and regulations. All participants shall ensure that his or her equipment (bicycle with accessories and other devices fitted, headgear, clothing, etc.) does not by virtue of its quality, material or design, constitute any danger to him/her or to others. All equipment shall be checked by the commissaire before each event.

# 11. RULES & REGULATIONS



**11.1.** The 41<sup>st</sup> Asian Track Championships, 28<sup>th</sup> Asian Junior Track Championships and .....Para Asian Track Championships 2022 will be conducted in accordance with the latest Rules and Regulations of the International Cycling Union (UCI) and the Asian Cycling Confederation (ACC). In case of disagreement in the translation of the rules, the English text shall prevail. Any General issues: Resolved in accordance with UCI and ACC Constitution. The UCI penalty scale is the only one applicable.

## 11.2. Participation

**11.2.1.1** As per UCI Regulations 10.1.005, all National Federations affiliated to Asian Cycling Confederation can take part in the 41<sup>st</sup> Asian Track Championships, 28<sup>th</sup> Asian Junior Track Championships and ....<sup>th</sup> Para Asian Track Championships 2022. EXTRACT FROM UCI REGULATIONS (CHAPTER X. CONTINENTAL CHAMPIONSHIPS)

**\*10.1.005** All National Federations affiliated to their Continental Association and only these, can take part in Continental Championships races. The maximum number of riders taking part in the various races will be the same for all these Federations.

**10.1.006** A rider against whom an investigation was opened in relation to affect which may cause a breach of UCI Anti-Doping Rules, will not be eligible for the Continental Championships and is not authorized to participate in the Continental Championships until the end of suspension or until his definitive acquittal. In the event of a positive A sample, this clause applies starting from the notification of the abnormal analysis result to the rider. Unless otherwise decided by the anti-doping commission, the above paragraph is also applicable in the event of an investigation or a procedure regarding such fact, opened in pursuance of a law or other regulation. Specific cases are examined by the anti-doping commission or its president. Their decision is without appeal.

\* In addition to the disqualification, the licensee and his or her National Federation will be respectively sanctioned by a fine of CHF 2000 to CHF 10000. The present condition for participation, aims to protect the integrity, serenity and reputation of the Championships. Its application does not prejudge the decision whether an anti-doping violation has occurred and shall not give right to any claim in the events of acquittal.

### **11.2.1.2: Age of Competitors**

Participation in Elite Categories shall be open to riders of 19 years and over. Junior Categories shall be open to riders born in 2004 – 2005 (18 and 17 years old).

## 12. TECHNICAL INFORMATION



**12.1.** If riders wearing the same team clothing ride in the same race, they shall bear some item to distinguish between them. Riders may carry no object on them or on their bicycles that could drop onto the track. They may not carry or use of the including mobile phone. Road bikers are not allowed on the track including the apron.

### 12.2 Race Clothing

Riders of the same national team must wear identical racing shorts during the same event, excerpts for advertising space included in a lateral bank 9 cm wide, which may differ from one rider to another. This means that National Federations must also provide their riders with national racing shorts. Team Managers must therefore present the National apparel to the College of Commissaries at the confirmation of the starters.

1.3.056 National federations shall submit to the commissaries panel of events as specified in art 1.3.059, a sample of their national team clothing for validation. The design, color, place and size of advertising spaces of the validated equipment must be identical for all athletes participating to the applicable events.

## 13. OFFICIAL CEREMONY



**13.1.** In accordance with the order set in the program published by the organizer. The Asian Champion, second and third placed riders shall be ready for the official ceremony which shall be conducted under the responsibility of Chief Commissaire as per the organizer advice.

**13.2.** The following arrangement shall apply to the official ceremonies. Within 10 minutes following the end of each race (unless otherwise provided and duly recorded in an official communiqué), the Asian Champion, second and third placed riders shall be ready for the official ceremony which shall be conducted under the responsibility of the Chief Commissaire as per advise of Organizer. They cannot move until the official ceremony is completed. Any infringement of the provisions of articles 9.1.044 to 9.1.050 above shall be punished by a fine of CHF 2,000 to CHF 10,000 minimum. A higher fine may be imposed depending on the advantage derived from the offence.

**13.3.** All the participating Cycling Federations are required to bring 2 number of National Flag measuring 1.x2m (3 feet x 6 feet) and a National anthem pendrive and handover to the organizer.

## 14. VEHICLES



**14.1.** The organizer will provide buses from the official hotel to races venues in an hourly basis (the bus schedule will be announced to all teams upon arrival)

## 15. INSURANCE

**15.1.** All participants (including but not limited to team officials, riders and their assistants) should be aware that they bear their own responsibility for any injury, accident and/or lost that may occur during their stay in India while taking part in this championship. Participants should take up proper insurance before leaving their country in order to protect themselves against any loss and to indemnify themselves against any claims.

## 16. STORAGE

Storage space will be provided to the participating teams at Cycling Velodrome. It shall be independent for each team or on sharing basis depending upon the size of the teams.

UCI will appoint the Doping Control Officers or DCO and ISN will appoint the Doping Control Doctor, nurses and Chaperons. The Doping Control Station for Track Events is located at the Cycling Velodrome, IG complex , New Delhi.
